
Our Adult Support and Protection team has received a Notice of Concern from Newtown Infirmary regarding the health and welfare of Isobel Stewart.

Part One of the Adult Support and Protection (Scotland) Act 2007 places a duty on the local authority to make enquiries if it knows or believes that an adult may be at risk. Therefore, in line with the local adult support and protection protocols, which Care at Home Ltd has agreed to follow, I would like to meet with you to discuss the concerns raised by medical staff at Newtown Infirmary relating to the care and support given to Mrs Stewart by your service.
