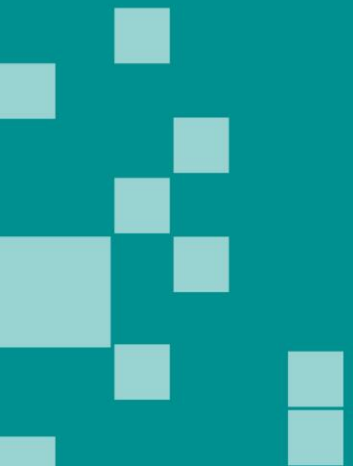

Format

Exceptional 2 points	Satisfactory 1 point	Needs work 0 points
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Well-structured and presented evidence.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Meets or exceeds the word count and the correct badge has been applied for.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Either falls short of minimum word count, evidence provided is for the wrong badge or is not accessible.



Format - needs work indicators

- Evidence submitted is irrelevant or for the wrong badge.
- Evidence is inaccessible.
- Minimum word count has not been met.
- Any part of the evidence identifies the learner or someone else.



Format – satisfactory indicators

- Evidence is accessible and relevant to the badge.
- Minimum word counts for each question have been met.
- Supporting documents (if required) have been supplied.
- Nobody can be identified from the evidence provided.



Format – excellent indicators

- Evidence submitted uses the badge criteria as headings.
- Evidence is presented or written well.
